



International Student Tuition and Annual Fees: 2025–2026

Tuition

Tuition is due and payable in full on **July 1** of every year. Totals include a \$5,000 international student fee.

Annual Fees

Annual, non-refundable fees offset the costs of registration, classroom and practical arts supplies, books, and performances for the students and the farm program. **Fees are due June 1 for the coming school year.**

English Language Support

\$5,000

All English language learners will need English Language Support classes until they can demonstrate English proficiency. English proficiency for 7th grade and up is a score of 80 or higher on the TOEFL exam (or equivalent).

Other Costs

Application Fee: A non-refundable fee of \$150 per child must be submitted with each application for new enrollment.

Annual Giving Campaign: This campaign launches in October of every year and we ask that all families participate.

After-School Program: After-school care is offered every weekday until 5:30pm for students in Kindergarten – 8th grade. Hourly rates range from \$15 – \$16.

Lunch: Daily organic lunch for purchase at \$10 – \$11 per day.

Miscellaneous: These may include instruments and music lessons, field trips, after-school activities, sports teams, and high school elective choices. Teachers may also recommend tutoring, external consultations or services at parents' expense.

Tuition Assistance: Students on an F-1 student visa are not eligible for tuition assistance.
