How to Apply ONLINE to Summerfield Waldorf School and Farm

Go to www.summerfieldwaldorf.org;

Step 1: Complete our Online Database Form;

Step 2: Parents complete the Parent Questionnaire (fillable pdf);

Step 3: Fill-out and return the two Release of Records forms (fillable pdf);

Step 4: *Optional:* Parents are invited to include a note commenting on the nature and personality of their student;

Step 5: Submit all completed materials to admissions@summerfieldwaldorf.org, along with:

- to expedite the process, copies of the last two years of your student's school records, and;
- a \$95 Application Fee (\$150 for the International Application). Pay online (by ACH* or Credit Card), or in person. *ACH is the preferred method of payment so your entire fee goes to the school rather than a portion being paid to the credit card companies.

Interview Process: Once we have received your child's application you will be contacted to set up visit days and an interview by either the class teacher or the Admissions Director. As a general practice teachers appreciate the opportunity of a pre-conversation with your child's current teacher. Interviews with the parents and child are conducted by the class teacher.

Acceptance: Summerfield Waldorf School and Farm is Sonoma County's oldest nonsectarian independent private school, seeking applicants who are responsible, wish to develop their creative potential, and who bring a diversity of interests, abilities, ethnic and socioeconomic backgrounds to the student body. Admission is open to all qualified students regardless of race, creed, gender or sexual orientation and is based on a review of academic transcripts, personal interviews, and teacher recommendations.

Financial Assistance: Beginning December 1 of each year, one may apply for financial assistance via Summerfield's website at www.summerfieldwaldorf.org.
